EAST INVICTA ASA MASTERS CHAMPIONSHIPS

Saturday 7th April 2018 Conditions of Entry

The Championships will be run under ASA Rules and ASA Technical Laws and East Invicta General Conditions.

1 The following Age Groups shall be promoted for both sexes:

A – 25/29	B – 30/34	C – 35/39	D-40/44	E – 45/49	F – 50/54	G – 55/59
H – 60/64	J – 65/69	K – 70/74	L – 75/79	M – 80/84	N — 85/89	

There will be an XX Age Group for 18 - 24 years which will be held for Individual Events only. There will be no relay events for the XX group and no XX group swimmers will be permitted to enter any team events. All XX group swimmers must be 18 years or over on the date of the Championships.

Competitors in Group A must be 25 years or over on the date of the Championships otherwise ages are taken as at 31st December in the year of the Championships.

2 There will be a 'Best Club' award decided on a points system as follows: $1^{st} - 3 \text{ points}$ $2^{nd} - 2 \text{ points}$ $3^{rd} - 1 \text{ point}$

We plan to present the trophy at the social gathering immediately after the gala to the Club gaining the most points for the Championships. We also plan to award the East Invicta Masters Swimmers of the Year trophies to the male & female competitors gaining the most points in the Championships. For these individual trophies points will be awarded on the basis of 'age adjusted times' from the results of all competitors.

3 Events for all age groups are:

a) Individual Events – Men and Ladies					
50m Butterfly	50m Backstroke				
50m Freestyle	100m Freestyle				

50m Breaststroke 100m Individual Medley

b) Team Events – Men and Ladies – (except XX group) 120 years 4 x 50m Freestyle and Medley Relay 160 years 4 x 50m Freestyle and Medley Relay 200 years 4 x 50m Freestyle and Medley Relay

Team races are limited to two teams per club for each age group. All Team Entry Forms must have names and ages on for all team members before posting at the event.

- 4 All events shall be decided on heat times. Finals will not be swum. Awards will be made to the first three competitors in each age group for each event.
- 5 In the Individual Championships listed in 3(a) above the entries will be seeded in the programme from best times submitted by entrants on their Entry Forms by listing them in time order. Slowest first, irrespective of age group.
- 6 All events will be pre-heated details of which will be available on a programme at the beginning of the Championships. Swimmers should present themselves to the officials at the start two heats before they are due to swim.
- 7 Entries will be managed on a computer. By submitting entries consent is given as required under the Data Protection Act 1984, to the holding of personal information on a computer. Personal data handled, such as name, club membership will be made public during the meet.
- 8 Entry fee £4.00 for each Individual event: £6.00 for each Team event
- 9 Entries should be made on the forms/CD provided (photocopies accepted). One form only per swimmer to show all the Individual Events being entered. Team entries should be submitted on the Team Entry form. Please submit times for 25m pool. Where no time is submitted you will be placed immediately before the slowest time submitted on the start list.
